 - Please submit a separate check for each desired club in case a club you select is full or cancelled.
 - Alumni, siblings, and friends of Excelsior students are welcome to join any enrichment clubs.
 - Enrollment for any Excelsior Enrichment Clubs is on a first-come, first-serve basis. If a desired club is full, your child will be put on a wait list.
 - If a club does not meet the minimum required enrollment, it may be cancelled, and you will be fully refunded.
 - Please note that tuition for any Excelsior Enrichment Clubs is non-refundable due to absence, illness, or change of heart.
 - Following the end of the school day, students are dropped off to their club by parents or guardian. Children registered in Extended Day will be split up into their assigned group following clubs for that day by our staff.
